# PRE CONFERENCE WORKSHOP

The 4th Karnataka State Conference of IAPSM was conducted at SS Institute of Medical Science and Research centre , Davanagere on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> September 2024 under the support and encouragement of Sri. Dr. Shamanuru Shivashankarappa, Honorary Secretary, BEA, MLA, Davanagere (South); Sri.S.S. Mallikarjun, Cabinet Minister, Mines and Geology and Horticulture, MLA, Davanagere (North), GoK, Joint Secretary, BEA, Chairman, SSIMSRC and Smt Dr. Prabha Mallikarjun, Member of Parliament, Davanagere, Governing Council Member, BEA, Council Member, SSIMSRC, Life trustee, SS Care Trust.

The event began with two pre-conference workshops. The first pre conference workshop was on 'Mastering Routine immunization: From supply chain to service delivery' which covered the comprehensive understanding of universal immunization programme. The second workshop was on 'PRIME-AI: Precision Research with Innovative Methods in AI' which focused on advanced skills in practical application of AI tools for research writing. The workshops saw the enthusiastic participation of over 60 delegates.



# INAUGURAL CEREMONY

The Inaugural program of 4<sup>th</sup> Karnataka State Conference of IAPSM was a momentous occasion, bringing together esteemed dignitaries and delegates. The event commenced with a warm welcome and a series of insightful speeches. Dr. Aswin Kumar, Organizing Chairperson, KARCON -24 delivered the welcome address. Delegates were then addressed by Dr. Arun Kumar Ajjappa, Medical Director, SSIMS and RC, Dr. Annarao Kulkarni, President National – IAPSM, Dr. Poonam Naik, President, IAPSM Karnataka State Chapter. Guest of Honour, Maj Gen (Prof.) Atul Kotwal, Executive Director, National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC), MoHFW GoI, delivered a keynote address on 'One Planet, One Health: A Unified Approach to Global Health Challenges'. Presidential address was delivered by Dr. B.S.Prasad, Principal, SSIMS and RC. Dr. Asha B, Joint secretary – IAPSM – Karnataka State chapter, Organizing Secretary KARCON - 24 concluded the program with a vote of thanks.
