

NEARBY PLACES TO VISIT

BADAMI CAVES

Badami is a small town renowned for its ancient rock-cut cave temples and structural temples.

With its stunning red sandstone cliffs and rich cultural heritage, Badami is a must-visit destination for those interested in history and architecture.

It is situated just 32 kms from Bagalkote



PATTADAKAL AND AIHOLE

Pattadakal located on the banks of the Malaprabha River, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is a testament to the richness of 7th & 8th Century Chalukyan architecture with its intricately chiselled temples.

Aihole village is known as “cradle of Hindu/Dravidian temple architecture

These are located about 40 kms from Bagalkote.



ALMATTI DAM GARDENS

The Lal Bahadur Shastri Dam is also known as Almatti Dam, is a hydroelectric project on the Krishna River.

The colorful fountains & laser show in evening; with the Mughal garden, Rock garden, Lav-Kush garden & Gopal Krishna garden making this a perfect weekend getaway spot.

It is located about 40 kms from Bagalkote.



KUDALASANGAMA

Kudalasangama is a major pilgrimage center and a tourist destination. The Krishna River and Ghataprabha River merge here and flow east towards Srisailem.


You can visit the Sangamanatha Temple, the Aikya Linga of Basaveshwara, the Mahamane Campus of the Basava Dharma Peetha, and the Poojavana. It is located about 52kms from Bagalkote



VIJAYAPURA

Vijayapura is well known for its historical monuments of architectural importance built during the rule of the Adil Shahi dynasty. Golgumbaz is one of the major attraction. it houses many other architectural structures such as Ibrahim Roza, Bara kaman etc.

Vijayapura also has the 2nd tallest Shiva statue in Shivgiri , which is 85 feet. These places are located around 85-90kms from Bagalkote.
